



YOUTH BURSARY AWARD APPLICATION

4 AWARDS GIVEN PER YEAR TO BE DISTRIBUTED JAN 1ST OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR

2 Bursaries, one \$500 and one \$250 will be awarded to applicants aged 17-21

2 Bursaries, one \$500 and one \$250 will be awarded to applicants aged 6-16

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a junior member of the Canadian Speckle Park Association and/or show a purebred Speckle Park or commercial Speckle Park as a 4-H project
- Must be 21 years of age or younger at the time of application
- Funds must be used for training, conferences, schooling or travel for agricultural purposes
- Applicants have 1 year from time of being awarded bursary to utilize funds. If the bursary is not used by deadline, applicants need to reapply

All applications must be completed and submitted by **November 1st** of each year to be considered for the bursary program award. The CSPA Board of Directors will select from the Applicants which will be announced January 1st.

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- 1 Page biography of the nominee including agricultural & breed involvement
- Describe intentions of use for bursary award

UPON RECEIVING BURSARY AND ACTIVITY COMPLETION:

- Provide a detailed report on how the bursary was used
- Provide proof of receipts for expenditures which the bursary was used towards.
